









MERICAN

37 "This is the Moses who told the Israelites, 'God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your own people.'









HEBREWS 3:1-6



- "just a quiet place to sit and rest.



- "well, an old stump is good for sitting and resting. Come, Boy, sit down. Sit down and rest."




